OF Lionshare Advisory Services**


Lionshare Advisory Services provides consultation on the development of wind and solar energy projects including site evaluation, land owner and community relations, local tax agreements, environmental assessment oversight and pre-engineering micro-siting and design refinement.

We are concerned that the Public Utility Commission ("Commission") has undervalued the feasibility for solar energy to serve as a solution to threatened resource inadequacy in ERCOT. Solar generation can reasonably be constructed and deployed more swiftly than other generation resources. We hope that the Commission will establish a workshop to address the advantages of encouraging available solar technology for ERCOT generation resources.

WHEREFORE, Lionshare Advisory Services respectfully prays that the commission set up a workshop under a separate docket involving solar resources.
