On Tuesday June 3, 2008, the commission will hold a workshop on Project No. 34037 - Discussion related to 9-1-1 Interconnection and Database issues. The workshop will begin at 9:30 a.m. in the Hearing Room Gee located on the seventh floor of the William B. Travis Building, 1701 North Congress Avenue, Austin, Texas 78701. Before the workshop commences, the commission requests that interested persons file comments addressing the questions below. The workshop agenda will not be confined solely to questions proposed by the commission staff; a portion of the workshop will be reserved for open discussion of general or specific issues of interest to attendees.

Questions for comment:

- 1. What action(s) should be required or undertaken by a CTU to fulfill its E-9-1-1 obligation(s) as a prerequisite to providing local exchange telephone service? Please address whether or not and how the commission's rules should distinguish between CTUs that provide local exchange telephone service to end user customers and those that do not. For each action given, please identify all PUC rules that currently require or prohibit such action.**
- 2. Under what circumstances should a CTU with existing 9-1-1 trunks or direct, dedicated voice paths in place be allowed to remove those 9-1-1 trunks or voice paths while still serving end-user customers requiring 9-1-1 access? Please explain your response.**
- 3. Should the designated 9-1-1 entity ensure that each CTU has satisfied its E9-1-1 obligation(s)?**
- 4. Should the commission establish E9-1-1 interconnection standards?**
- 5. Should the commission open a rulemaking to consider E9-1-1 database issues?**
