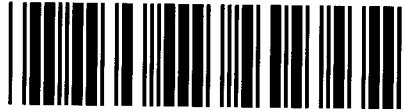

30 Day Notice of Withdrawal

Dear Ms. Hudgins:

EnerNOC, Inc. ("EnerNOC" or the "Company") respectfully submits this Notice of Withdrawal of its Aggregation Registration No. 80346 pursuant to the Public Utility Commission of Texas ("PUC") Substantive Rule 25.111(i)(10). Specifically, §25.111(i)(10) states that registered aggregators that cease to provide aggregation services may withdraw their registration by notifying the Commission 30 days prior to ceasing operations and providing proof of refund of any monies owed to customers.

Attached please find a notarized affidavit signed by EnerNOC's President, David Brewster, stating that nothing is owed to EnerNOC's customers (EnerNOC does not take deposits or advance payments from electricity customers for electricity supply), and that the Company does not have any aggregation customers.

EnerNOC is also filing under a separate cover letter its Annual Report Form for Aggregators for the Reporting Period of July 1, 2013 to June 30, 2014 ("Report"). This Report explains that the Company has not had any aggregated customers during the Reporting Period, so EnerNOC has no substantive data to report.

EnerNOC has determined upon closer review of the applicable Commission rule that the Company is not required to be registered as an aggregator given the nature of its business in Texas. Specifically, Commission Rule 25.111(a) states that the requirement to register as an aggregator applies when the entity "aggregates...customers for purposes of purchasing electricity services." EnerNOC does not join two or more customers together into a purchasing unit to negotiate the purchase of electricity from retail electric providers, and therefore does not meet the definition of aggregator for which registration is required.


